Hogarth Falls & People's Park

Walk through rainforest alongside Botanical Creek to relaxing Hogarth Falls.



Basic Facts

Where:	Peoples Park, Strahan
Return distance:	3km
Return walking time:	40 minutes
Surface:	Gravel
Walk Difficulty:	Easy

Getting There

From the Strahan Council Chambers on the Esplanade, travel towards Regatta Point to Peoples Park which is 1.5 km from the Strahan wharf area.

Nearby Facilities

There is a car park and toilet facilities at People's Park which has a grassed area suitable for children to play and picnics.

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The walk

Stroll along an almost level and well formed track through mixed forest to Hogarth Falls. View towering gum trees and species typical of cool temperate rainforest such as leatherwood, sassafras and myrtle.

Dogs are welcome if kept on a leash. Bicycles are not welcome. There is flowing water so supervision of children is necessary.

Walking Safety

Before embarking on a walk, please consider the following:

1. Where possible, stay on formed tracks;
2. Only attempt walks within your capabilities, if unsure seek medical and/or professional advice;
3. Never jump or dive into natural waterways;
4. Watch your step, keep away from cliff edges, waterfalls and slippery rocks;
5. Carry a supply of drinking water;
6. Enjoy your walk.
