## Stitt River Park to Rosebery Park



### Basic Facts

Nearest town:	Rosebery
Return distance:	Short
Walking time:	20 minutes
Surface:	Gravel
Walk Difficulty:	Easy

### Getting There

Stitt River Park is beside the Murchison Highway just south of Rosebery.

### The walk

The marked track commences at the Stitt River Park.

### Walking Safety

Before embarking on a walk, please consider the following:

1. Where possible, stay on formed tracks;
2. Only attempt walks within your capabilities, if unsure seek medical and/or professional advice;
3. never jump or dive into natural waterways;
4. watch your step, keep away from cliff edges, waterfalls and slippery rocks;
5. carry a supply of drinking water;
6. enjoy your walk.
